

# Petition Instructions

Thank you for helping our petition drive. It is important to collect as many signatures as possible, so I am encouraging everyone to print at least 1 form, and fill it in and return it to me, even if you just complete a line for each registered voter in your household. There are lots of people in Arkansas, if 450 people each send in 25 signatures we would easily have enough signatures (including those discarded for various reasons) to put an independent candidate for Federal office on the General Election ballot in Arkansas for the first time. But if we simply had 5500 households submit 2 signatures each, the same result. Each signature is important, and I am honored by those that I have received and those that I will. Help make history, please print, complete and return a copy of this petition even if it has just one name on it.

If you are reading this page, you have certainly spent some time on my website and know many of my campaign messages. While it is important to introduce my campaign, that is not the purpose of this petition drive. Make sure that your signers are aware that they are simply adding their names to a petition to put an independent candidate on the ballot in November because there is no other way to get that person on the ballot. Make sure they understand that this is a procedural issue, not an endorsement of my campaign.

There will be lots of time to campaign for office once we assure I have a place on the ballot. So I ask you to please direct your enthusiasm to collect as many valid signatures as possible as quickly as possible. Once the magic number has been reached, we can begin the fight for the election in earnest.

You can collect signatures anywhere you want to, as long as you have permission of the property owner if it is on private property. Churches, schools, offices, public gatherings, stores, anywhere you can get permission. Be creative and enthusiastic, have a positive attitude, and we will reach the goal with time to spare.

Please do not use any form other than this petition form to collect signatures. The Secretary of State will disallow any signatures that are not printed on a form containing the entire wording of the petition proposal.

You do not have to fill in an entire form. If you are collecting at an event, it has been suggested that you bring several clipboards and have your first signers fill in the top 2 spots on each, then start crowd collecting with the partially completed forms. People are more comfortable adding their names to a petition than being the first to sign one.

All signatures must be from persons registered to vote in the state of Arkansas. Any signatures of voters not registered in Arkansas, or individuals that are not registered voters, will be discarded. All duplicate signatures will be discarded. All incomplete signature lines and all lines that are illegible will be discarded.

Please make sure the petition is filled out in ink. Any signatures written with erasable media will be discarded.

The devil is in the details, they say, and it is true here. It has been notoriously difficult to get on the ballot as an independent in Arkansas, let's not create problems for our effort by not paying full attention to the details.

You do not have to wait to completely fill the forms, I suggest you mail what you have collected every 5 days. Please try to have all the pages in the mail (postmarked) by the April 23<sup>rd</sup> so that they can be sure to reach me and be checked before the deadline for filing the petition on May 1<sup>st</sup> at noon.
